British Electric Foundation presents Heaven 17 performing Penthouse And Pavement live for the very first time

Now, as it was then...from the partnership that's opening doors all over the world....

In 2010 Heaven 17 will perform their seminal 1981 album of the year 'Penthouse And Pavement' live in its entirety for the very first time.

Featuring original members – lead singer Glenn Gregory and synthesist and vocalist Martyn Ware, together with backing vocalist Billie Godfrey, electric guitarist Asa Bennett, Joel Farland on electronic percussion and legendary bass guitaristRandy Hope-Taylor.

Lighting designer Pip Rhodes will coordinate a live digital visual show featuring some of the biggest names and most talented up-and-coming artists from the worlds of digital and graphic design, fine art and film, including Chris Bird (<u>United Visual Artists</u>), graphic designer <u>Malcolm Garrett</u>, Mike Faulkner (<u>D-Fuse</u>), famous artist <u>Tim Head</u>, Ian Anderson(<u>Designers Republic</u>), Ross Phillips (<u>ShowStudio</u>), Brian Duffy (<u>Modified Toy Orchestra</u>), <u>James</u> <u>Strong</u>, Kim Leliboux, Ed Cookson (<u>The Sancho Plan</u>), BAFTA-winning filmmaker Julian Henriques, <u>James</u> Bates, Ben Tomlinson, Chris Cheeseman and, of course, Pip Rhodes and Heaven 17 themselves.

The event will be curated from the moment the audience enters the venue, as the LED wall will be showing the visual artists' interpretations of BEF compositions from the same period, including tracks from BEF albums 'Music For Stowaways' and 'Music Of Quality And Distinction Vol.1' – and all artists have been allowed to express their interpretations freely with no prior guidance from Heaven 17. The artists contributing to this 'group show' will be credited – this will be a world-first multimedia show – part art installation and part concer – the evening culminating with Penthouse And Pavement being performed in its entirety, the two sides punctuated by specialBEF performances featuring surprise guest singers.
